

Okaloosa County residents may get a free Fort Walton Beach library card. Applicants need to show two things to apply-- a **photo ID and proof of residence**, such as a current piece of mail, utility bill, car registration, or check book showing applicant's name and current address.

Students who attend Okaloosa County schools but who reside outside of the county may obtain a free card for the current semester when they provide proof of registration or a current college ID card.

Winter visitors and temporary residents of Okaloosa County-- a 6-month family library card for **\$20**. This includes those residing less than 6 months out of the year in Okaloosa County, temporary military and motel or boat residents. TDY and relocating military may present a copy of orders.

Residents of Walton, Santa Rosa and surrounding counties-- \$75 for a one-year family library card.

Your full-privilege Ft. Walton Beach Library card is good at all of the other five libraries that make up the **Okaloosa County Public Library Cooperative--** Destin, Mary Esther, Valparaiso, Niceville, and Crestview libraries. Temporary cards and special cards may not be honored at other libraries for all services.

Your full-privilege library card provides access to the library's online catalog and account information. Your login is your barcode number and the PIN. The default PIN is *changeme* and should be changed when you first log in.
